



EVESHAM RAMBLERS: BRETFTON AND WILLERSEY (7.0MIS 52M)

## Route Information

Evesham Ramblers: Bretforton and Willersey (7.0mls 52m)

A pleasant flat walk through the Vale countryside between the villages of Bretforton and Willersey. Peaceful and rural with far ranging views across the Vale for much of the way.

Additional Notes: Easy walking on field paths and farm tracks, with very little tarmac. Just two or three stiles. Could be a bit overgrown in places. Likely to meet some livestock (sheep and possibly cattle). Suitable for dogs on leads

Recommended start point: The Fleece Inn, Bretforton WR11 7JE (grid ref 093 438). Park in the small parking area between the pub and church or else considerately on the roadside in the village.

Suggested snack stop: Willersey village green, opposite The Bell Inn (grid ref 105 396). There are several benches available to sit on here. A lovely spot, highly recommended.
